Programme Title:

Training to become a Veterinary Pathologist
(Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Pathologists)
(Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Pathologists)

Brief content description:

Our residency programme, recognised by the European College of Veterinary Pathologists (ECVP), enables candidates to apply for the ECVP or ACVP board exams. Veterinarians who have completed at least a 1-year internship according to ECVP requirements undergo practical and theoretical training in gross and microscopic pathology of domestic and zoo animals. There is an opportunity to conduct a veterinary medical dissertation (Dr. med. vet.) through a research project in one of the research groups of the ITPA, which can be counted as part of the internship.

Combined Residency-PhD Programme:

In addition to training in veterinary pathology, a combined training programme is offered in connection with biomedical research.

Duration and Location:

Minimum of 3 years in Bern, Institute of Animal Pathology, Länggassstr. 122, CH-3012 Bern
Combined Residency-Dissertation (Dr. med. vet.) Programme: approximately 4-5 years
Combined Residency-PhD Programme: approximately 6 years
