

Specialisation Committee Vetsuisse Faculty Bern:

Residency Programme in Small Animal Internal Medicine (ACVIM)

Brief content description:

The primary goal of the programme is to train residents as specialists in small animal internal medicine. This is achieved through direct supervision of clinical cases (mostly referred or seeking a second opinion) under the guidance of a senior assistant, attending internal and external continuing education events, and conducting a clinical research project.

Duration and Location:

The programme lasts for 4 years. Apart from brief elective rotations at other institutions, the entire programme is conducted at the Vetsuisse Faculty in Bern.

According to the regulations: of the ACVIM

Programme Objective:

Attainment of the specialist title of the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine (ACVIM, Small Animal Internal Medicine).

Open positions:

Three training positions are offered over a 4-year cycle, alternating between ACVIM and ECVIM. Due to organizational reasons, not every year will see the employment of a resident.
